1. What we've been doing over the last year:
 - Begun a mentoring program for resident leaders within the APA
 - Initiated a recruiting project, coordinating with ACOM: training chief residents and other resident leaders about the benefits of the APA; working with the membership department to send those resident back to their programs to recruit resident membership
 - Meeting with resident leadership of RRC to better represent/coordinate resident education in the RRC and APA
 - Created a smaller version of our "handbook" to offer to all new components members
 - Worked toward increasing our "institutional memory" within CORF – created a more structured orientation to CORF, have a new CORF/ACOM mentor position created this year
2. Future plans:
 - Working to put PRN (Psychiatric Resident Newsletter) online: have several ways of doing this under discussion; have been talking with Dr. Freedman (AJP) about coordinating CORF's efforts with the Resident's Journal; working with Nancy and Caroline about best format if we independently publish it online
 - Expand our work in resident wellness – completed a chief resident survey several years ago and ACOM completed one this year – plan is to work together to develop programs for resident wellness based on some of the results
 - Increase resident involvement in AADPRT – may work to coordinate educational activities with members of AADPRT – Paul O'Leary attended this year and co-sponsored workshops may be in the future
