James E. Ninninger, M.D. Elected to APA Assembly Post

Local psychiatrist James E. Ninninger, M.D., has recently been elected speaker of the Assembly of the American Psychiatric Association (APA). Dr. Ninninger is a clinical associate professor of psychiatry at Cornell University and volunteers at Payne Whitney Clinic supervising, teaching, and interviewing resident applicants.

Dr. Ninninger has conducted a private practice in New York since completing a residency in psychiatry at Mt. Sinai Hospital. He was elected New York County District Branch representative to the APA Assembly in 1988.

Additionally, Dr. Ninninger is a Distinguished Fellow of the APA, immediate past-president of the New York State Psychiatric Association. He also served as the Assembly liaison to APA's Committee on Family Violence and Sexual Abuse. Dr. Ninninger resides in Yorktown Heights, NY.

Dr. Ninninger appointed local psychiatrist Edward Hanin, M.D., as his Parliamentarian.
