APA Past President to be Keynote Speaker at International Meeting

Arlington, Va. – Carolyn B. Robinowitz, M.D., past president of the American Psychiatric Association, will be the keynote speaker at the 10th Anniversary Meeting of the American Academy of Psychoanalysis and Dynamic Psychiatry (AAPDP) in Milan, Italy, Oct. 25 - 26.

Robinowitz has held many national leadership roles including presidencies of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, the American College of Psychiatrists, the Council of Medical Specialty Societies and the Association for Academic Psychiatry. Robinowitz, APA president from May 2007 to May 2008, was formerly dean of the Georgetown University School of Medicine, where she also served as associate dean for students and professor of psychiatry. Prior to her work at Georgetown, she was the senior deputy medical director and chief operating officer of the APA.
