Dr. Becker is an Associate Professor of Psychiatry and an Associate Professor of Medical Anthropology at Harvard Medical School. She is also the Director of the Eating Disorders Clinical and Research Program at Massachusetts General Hospital and is Director of the Social Sciences M.D.-Ph.D. Program at Harvard Medical School. Dr. Becker’s research focus has been on the impact of social and cultural environment on eating disorders and body image. Her current research investigates the impact of rapid social transition on risk for eating disorders. She serves as the Director of Teaching Days on the Board of Directors for the Academy for Eating Disorders. Dr. Becker is on the editorial boards of the *International Journal of Eating Disorders, Anthropology & Medicine*, and the *Harvard Review of Psychiatry*. She was co-editor in chief of *Culture, Medicine and Psychiatry* from 2000 until 2007.

Dr. Becker received her bachelor’s degree from Harvard College, summa cum laude. She received her medical training at Harvard Medical School and completed her residency in the Department of Psychiatry at the Massachusetts General Hospital in 1994. She also received a doctoral degree in anthropology from the Harvard Graduate School of Arts & Sciences and a master’s of science degree in epidemiology from the Harvard School of Public Health.
