#### **Biographical Sketch:**

Wilson received his B.A. degree (first class, 1965) and B.A. Hons (first class with distinction, 1965) from Witwatersrand University in Johannesburg, South Africa, and his Ph.D. from the State University of New York at Stony Brook (1971). He is currently the Oscar K. Buros Professor of Psychology and Director of Clinical Training in the clinical Ph.D program at Rutgers University, USA.

Wilson has co-authored or edited several books, including Binge Eating: Nature, Assessment, and Treatment (with Chris Fairburn); published numerous scientific articles; and is the editor of Behaviour Research and Therapy the leading international journal on CBT.

A former President of the Association for Advancement of Behavior Therapy (AABT – 1980-81), he has received several honors and awards for distinguished contributions to clinical psychology. He was twice a Fellow at the Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences at Stanford, California (1976-77; 1990-1991).

He has long been actively involved in funded clinical research on the evaluation of behavioral and cognitive therapies, and the analysis of mechanisms of change.

Among numerous other professional activities, Wilson was a member of the American Psychiatric Association's Work Group for eating disorders in DSM-IV, and a Member, NIH (National Institutes of Health) National Task Force on the Prevention and Treatment of Obesity (1995 – 2002)
