Biographical Sketch:

Dr. Paulsen is a clinical neuropsychologist with a long-standing interest in frontal-striatal behavioral and cognitive correlates in human brain. She has studied this area of the brain using several different populations (Alzheimers, Parkinson's, Huntington's, Schizophrenia, Major Depression, Obsessive Compulsive and Tourettes Disorders, Aspergers and Autism Spectrum Disorders, as well as head injury) and various methodologies (neuropsychological assessment, neurophysiological measures of evoked potential and pre-pulse inhibition, structural and functional brain imaging, participant self-report scales, structured interviews, qualitative interviews and focus groups). Dr. Paulsen works closely with clinical, ethical, and advocacy correlates of her research. She currently is the PI of a \$9-million, 30-site study to investigate brain disease before clinical diagnoses or functional declines are evident in an effort to design models for prevention of brain disease.
