Niklas Långström is a board-certified child and adolescent psychiatrist. He received his research training at the Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm, Sweden and earned his PhD degree on work with adolescent sexual offenders. Långström is Associate professor in child and adolescent psychiatry and Head of the Centre for Violence Prevention at Karolinska Institutet. He currently holds a Senior clinical researcher position at the Swedish Research Council – Medicine.

Dr Långström is interested in the etiology, assessment, and management of sexual deviance and sexual problem behavior, and non-sexual violent behaviour. He has (co)authored more than 30 peer-reviewed original articles and reviews in the field.
