**Biographical Sketch:**

Dr. Kathy Parker received her B.S.N. from Columbia University, her M.N. from Emory University, and her Ph.D. in Nursing from Georgia State University. She has over 20 years of clinical practice experience and is certified by the American Nurses Credentialing Center as both an adult nurse practitioner and medical/surgical clinical nurse specialist. She is also one of five nurses in the country certified in Clinical Sleep Disorders by the American Board of Sleep Medicine and was recently elected as a Fellow of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine and a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing. Dr. Parker maintains an active clinical practice as a nurse practitioner in the Emory Sleep Center where she provides care for patients with a variety of sleep disorders and problems. Her ongoing program of research is dedicated to the study of sleep/wake cycle disturbances in patients with chronic illness and the development and testing of population-specific interventions. She has conducted a number of federally funded studies in this area. Dr. Parker promotes an integrated, interdisciplinary approach; members of her team include nephrologists, neurologists, psychologists, psychiatrists, basic scientists, rehabilitation medicine specialists, and nurses.
