**Biographical Sketch:**

Dr. Sharpe has a personal research Chair in Psychological Medicine at the University of Edinburgh, UK. He is a specialist in Psychosomatic Medicine (Consultation Liaison Psychiatry).

His main interest is in understanding and treating the symptoms in patients attending medical services in order to improve their quality of life. He has particular expertise in non-pharmacologic interventions and in clinical trials to test these. Dr Sharpe is an associate editor of the Journal of Psychosomatic Research and General Hospital Psychiatry, and a Fellow of the Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine, the Royal Colleges of Physicians of London and of Edinburgh and the Royal College of Psychiatrists of the United Kingdom.

Dr Sharpe has a Masters in Experimental Psychology from the University of Oxford and an MD from the University of Cambridge, UK. He subsequently trained in psychiatry in Oxford. He has worked at the University of Edinburgh since 1997 where he leads the Psychological Medicine Research group.
