



2009-2010 APA/Shire Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship Program

Call for Applications

The American Psychiatric Association (APA) is pleased to announce that a seventh group of APA/Shire Child & Adolescent Fellows will be selected to attend the 2009 and 2010 APA Annual Meetings. The APA/Shire Child & Adolescent Fellowship is open to PGY-1 through PGY-3 residents in any ACGME-approved training program. Applicants must have the approval or support of their training director or department chairperson. *The resident must be a member of APA when she/he makes the application.*

Applications must be submitted by **December 17, 2008**. These fellowships are supported by an unrestricted educational grant from Shire Pharmaceuticals. The APA/Shire Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship program was established in 2002 to interest general psychiatry residents in considering careers in child and adolescent psychiatry by providing specific educational opportunities unavailable to them otherwise.

Five residents will be selected for the 2009-10 program. They will attend and participate in two APA Annual Meetings: May 16-21, 2009 in San Francisco, CA and May 22-27, 2010, in New Orleans, LA.

At these meetings, fellows will have opportunities to:

- meet and network with leaders in child and adolescent psychiatry
- meet and work with an eminent child and adolescent psychiatrist who will serve as a mentor to offer advice and assistance with preparing a program proposal for 2010
- acquaint her/himself with the field of child and adolescent psychiatry through attending a group of programs at these annual meetings
- be mentored in 2009 and provide mentoring to other awardees in 2010
- submit and present (if accepted) a workshop at the 2010 annual meeting

For 2009, each fellow will

- Attend the Annual Meeting as a participant
- Attend sessions focused on child and adolescent psychiatry
- Meet individually with her/his mentor
- Meet with the other mentors and other awardees in a group session where the mentors will recommend sessions which would be of particular interest to the fellows

For 2010, the second year, the fellow will

- Attend the Annual Meeting as a participant
- Meet as a group with the other APA/Shire fellows
- Attend sessions focused on child and adolescent psychiatry

- Present a workshop on a topic in child and adolescent psychiatry (with help from their mentor). The presentation will be subject to the approval of the APA Scientific Program Committee.

These awards will support travel and related costs for five residents to attend both the 2009 Annual Meeting in San Francisco, and the 2010 Meeting in New Orleans, LA.

Requirements:

- PGY1 to PGY 3 resident in an ACGME-accredited residency training program in general psychiatry
- Member of the APA
- Completed application form (see next page)
- 500-word letter of interest detailing experience, knowledge, and career path
- Letter of support from a residency training director or department chairperson including the resident's potential contribution to the field of child & adolescent psychiatry. (Only two applications will be accepted from a training program.)
