



Blanche F. Ittleson Award for Research in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry

Call for submissions

The Blanche F. Ittleson Award recognizes outstanding research in child and adolescent psychiatry. A \$2,000 prize and a plaque are presented at the American Psychiatric Association's (APA) Convocation of Fellows in May at its Annual Meeting.

This award is presented to a psychiatrist or to a group of psychiatric investigators for the published results of research in child and adolescent psychiatry that have resulted in, or promises to lead to, a significant advance in promoting the mental health of children. Results of the applicant's research must have been published within five years prior to the nomination to the Ittleson Award Selection Committee or officially accepted for publication in the near future.

**June 1, 2012 is the deadline for submission
of nominations for the 2013 award.**

Those who are nominating a person/group should submit a summary of the research being nominated, a cover letter, and a current vitae of the nominee(s). This material should be sent before the June 1, deadline to:
