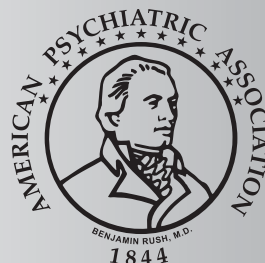

This important effort begins with APA's minority caucuses, which give minority psychiatrists the opportunity to explore mutual issues, voice diverse opinions, and promote needed change. Participation in an APA caucus is free and is reserved for APA members from minority and underrepresented groups (hereafter referred to as MUR).

Participating in a minority caucus gives MUR psychiatrists expanded opportunities within the Association and throughout the profession.

Caucus members meet during APA's spring Annual Meeting, where members advocate for minority patient populations, discuss social and health-related issues, and explore concerns related to professional growth and advancement for members.

Networking is an invaluable benefit of caucus participation. Joining a caucus links you to psychiatrists who share your background, interests, and goals.

Caucus members forge strong professional and personal bonds that often cross geographic boundaries and specialties. Members gain access to resources and support in their professional development.

Each minority caucus elects two representatives to the APA Assembly: a representative and a deputy representative. They have the same privileges and voting rights as district branch representatives. For many members, this role provides a route to leadership within the profession.
