**Call for Submissions**

The Agnes Purcell McGavin Award for Distinguished Career Achievement is presented to a child and adolescent psychiatrist who has made significant contributions in teaching, research and care for children and adolescents. He or she is presented a \$1,500 prize and a plaque by the American Psychiatric Association (APA) at the Convocation of Fellows in May at the Annual Meeting.

This award is given to a child/adolescent psychiatrist whose career has been noted for outstanding contributions to the advancement of child and adolescent psychiatry in activities including teaching, research, writing, clinical care, advocacy, and policy. Members of the McGavin Award Selection Committee are ineligible.
