

American Psychiatric Leadership Fellowship

Preparing future leaders in psychiatry

The two-year American Psychiatric Leadership Fellowship offers psychiatric residents, with exceptional leadership potential, many different experiences that prepare them for leadership roles. Those selected participate in a component of the APA governance structure, attend the APA Annual and September Component Meetings, have an opportunity to present a workshop at the Annual Meeting, receive leadership training, and more.

Eligibility

Psychiatric residents who are in their PGY II year of psychiatric residency at the time of nomination (or PGY III of a five-year program), **are members of the APA**, or have applied for membership and have passed all national or state board examinations needed for full (independent) state licensure (e.g. USMLE 1, 2 and 3, or COMLEX parts 1, 2 and 3, or Canadian LMCC, or QE parts 1 and 2) are eligible.

Residents who are members of the APA SAMHSA and Diversity Leadership Fellowship Programs or the APA Public Psychiatry Fellowship Program are INELIGIBLE.

Nomination & Selection

Each accredited psychiatric residency training program may nominate **one** resident. The training director submits the nominee's application materials.

The deadline for submissions to be received at APA is **January 12, 2012**.

Residents are chosen based upon: clinical skills; leadership; involvement in academic, health or community activities; academic accomplishments in research/publications; academic accomplishments in teaching; and the resident's personal statement (describing vision and career goals).

Support

The fellowship includes travel costs to the APA September Components and Annual Meetings.

Program Duration

The fellowship is two years long, beginning in September.
